Loachapoka Councilors are working with Emergency Management agencies in the search for approved shelters. LWV awareness of the issue and member assistance in time of disaster(s) is encouraged.

**Other Concerns:** None. It should be noted that Loachapoka Councilors and the Mayor are working with a number of different entities in an attempt to provide uninterrupted internet service to the Community. A comment was made that such service issues should be remedied within the next five (5) years.
