In the late 1990s and early 2000, the City Planning staff, Commission, and Council placed a great deal of effort in preserving the integrity of the U.S. 280 ("GATEWAY") Corridor by putting in place certain design guidelines with regards to site development, including architectural controls on building and signage design and landscaping; e.g., witness TigerTown. If the approval of the Express Car Wash (Agenda Item # C.9) is an indication of what's acceptable, the perception given by its approval suggests that those guidelines are on their way to being relaxed. (Compare this agenda item to the detailed design related discussion held on Agenda Item C.10 – RNR Tire Express to be situated on Pepperell Parkway.)
